Regular Full-Year Rotary Youth Exchange Program

The Rotary Clubs of Tigard will sponsor one or two full-year outbound students for the 2003/2004 year. We will be taking preliminary applications from current Sophomore students who would like to study abroad in their Junior Year (2003/2004). <u>Students are selected in September of their</u> Sophomore year for Junior year exchanges.

Currently, Rotary District 5100 is exchanging with 24+ countries around the world. District 5100 (Northern Oregon, Southern Washington) sponsors 50-70 full year outbound and a corresponding number of inbound students each school year. Deadline for preliminary Long Term applications is September 15, 2002 for exchange year 2002/2003.

Rotary's Long Term Youth Exchange program is open to young men and women in their Junior year. Applicants are selected as Sophomores on the basis of academic record, leadership potential, and community involvement through a written application and personal interview process.

This year, about 10,000 young people will see the world the way it is best seen – from the inside out – through Rotary's Youth Exchange Programs. This could be YOUR year!

Short Term Summer Rotary Youth Exchange Program – 2003

District 5100 also participates in the Rotary Short Term Exchange Program (STEP). STEP is open to 8th grade through college Sophomores and is a family-to-family exchange. Your son or daughter spends four weeks abroad with a family and when he/she returns, you host a student from this family for the next four weeks. STEP is not designed to replace our full year program, but rather enhance your opportunities to experience different cultures. **Deadline for Short Term applications is December 15, 2002 for Summer 2003 exchanges.**
