

ROTARY DISTRICT 5100 YOUTH EXCHANGE INBOUND RULES

These Rules Are For Your Health And Safety And To Help Insure That You Have A Successful Year As A Rotary Youth Exchange Student In Dist. 5100.

- Students should represent themselves, their home country, and Rotary in ways that
 reflect Rotary's values, commitment to Service Above Self, and as peacebuilders in their
 host community.
- 2. Students should respect each other and act responsibly, befitting their role as a representative of the program and of Rotary in the world.
- 3. Students should accept the supervision and authority of the host family and the host club or district during the exchange.
- 4. DRUGS: You are not allowed to abuse the use of drugs. The use of illegal drugs is prohibited.
- 5. ALCOHOL: You are not allowed to use alcohol. Alcohol is illegal for anyone under 21 years of age in Oregon and Washington.
- 6. SINGLE DATING is not allowed. Romantic attachments must be avoided.
- 7. NO OPERATING MOTORIZED VEHICLES: This includes cars, motorcycles, boats, planes, snowmobiles, trailbikes, etc.
- 8. Students should not travel outside the immediate area of the host club community without the consent of the host club and district, the students' parents or legal guardians.
- 9. NO INDEPENDENT TRAVEL: You may travel with your host family, other District 5100 Rotary approved families, or with a properly chaperoned school trip or function. NO TRAVEL ALONE OUTSIDE YOUR HOST CITY OR WITH OTHER YOUNG PEOPLE IS ALLOWED! See Inbound Student Guidelines for further information.
- 10. TOBACCO: Exchange students are not allowed to smoke or use tobacco products at any time.
- 11. SHOPLIFTING IS A CRIME: It is stealing and it will not be tolerated.
- 12. SCHOOL: You will attend school regularly and according to schedule. This is a high school exchange program, NOT A HOLIDAY! Even if you have graduated at home, IN THE UNITED STATES YOU WILL ATTEND HIGH SCHOOL EVERY DAY.
- 13. CHANGING HOST FAMILIES: You will move when told by your hosting Rotary club.
- 14. TRAVEL FROM YOUR COUNTRY AND RETURN: You will come directly from your country to the United States stopping only long enough to transfer planes and fly to Portland, Oregon International Airport (PDX). Your return home will be directly to your country with no stopovers.
- 15. AIRLINE TICKETS: You must arrive with a fully paid, round-trip, open return airline ticket in your possession or sufficient additional funds to purchase a return ticket. If you are bringing additional funds to purchase your return ticket, at a more convenient date, those funds must be deposited with the District 5100 YEC or designated travel agent chosen by the District 5100 YEC. NO STANDBY TICKETS ALLOWED!





- 16. INSURANCE: You must buy on-line from Bolduc (www.CISI-Bolduc.com), PLAN B insurance prior to arrival and bring the policy and ID card with you. ALL STUDENTS MUST PAY FOR THIS POLICY, unless otherwise approved in advance by D5100.
- 17. DIRECT COMMUNICATIONS: NO TELEPHONE CALLS/SKYPE/CHAT/TEXTING FROM BOYFRIENDS OR GIRLFRIENDS IN YOUR HOME COUNTRY ARE EVER ALLOWED! We prefer students do not have this sort of direct communications with natural parents for the first 90 days of their stay. Early direct communications contribute to serious cases of homesickness. Students should tell their natural parents that they should not call unless it is an emergency, and that emergency call MUST BE ROUTED THROUGH THE DISTRICT 5100 YOUTH EXCHANGE COMMITTEE.
- 18. WHILE IN THE UNITED STATES YOU SHOULD MAKE YOUR FRIENDS AMONG THE AMERICANS. You are here to learn about the American people. Only through your American friends will you learn to know this country. Be aware of this and watch for signs of "gravitating" toward the other exchange students.
- 19. ENGLISH IS SPOKEN IN THE UNITED STATES. You will be expected to speak English exclusively while in the United States.
- 20. ROTARY EVENT ADDITIONAL RULES: Youth Exchange Events are intended to be educational and enjoyable experiences for all who attend. To accomplish this, we need everyone to comply with the following conditions.
 - a. Students are expected to attend all scheduled events and meetings. Be on time for your sessions.
 - b. Students are assigned to rooms. You are not allowed to switch rooms without Rotary approval.
 - c. Girls are NEVER allowed in boys rooms and boys are NEVER allowed in girls rooms.
 - d. Students must be in their assigned rooms with doors closed no later than midnight (or announced time). Quiet after midnight.
 - e. Students are not allowed to leave the event premises without prior approval from Rotary.
 - f. Students are responsible for your own personal property.
 - g. Students must wear their name badges to all meetings and meals
 - h. Students: No smoking, No alcohol, and No drugs at any Rotary Event.

Things Are Different Than In Your Country. If You Want Things Like They Are At Home, if Some Of Our Rules Do Suit You And You Don't Wish To Abide By Them, Then You Should Not Be An Exchange Student.
