

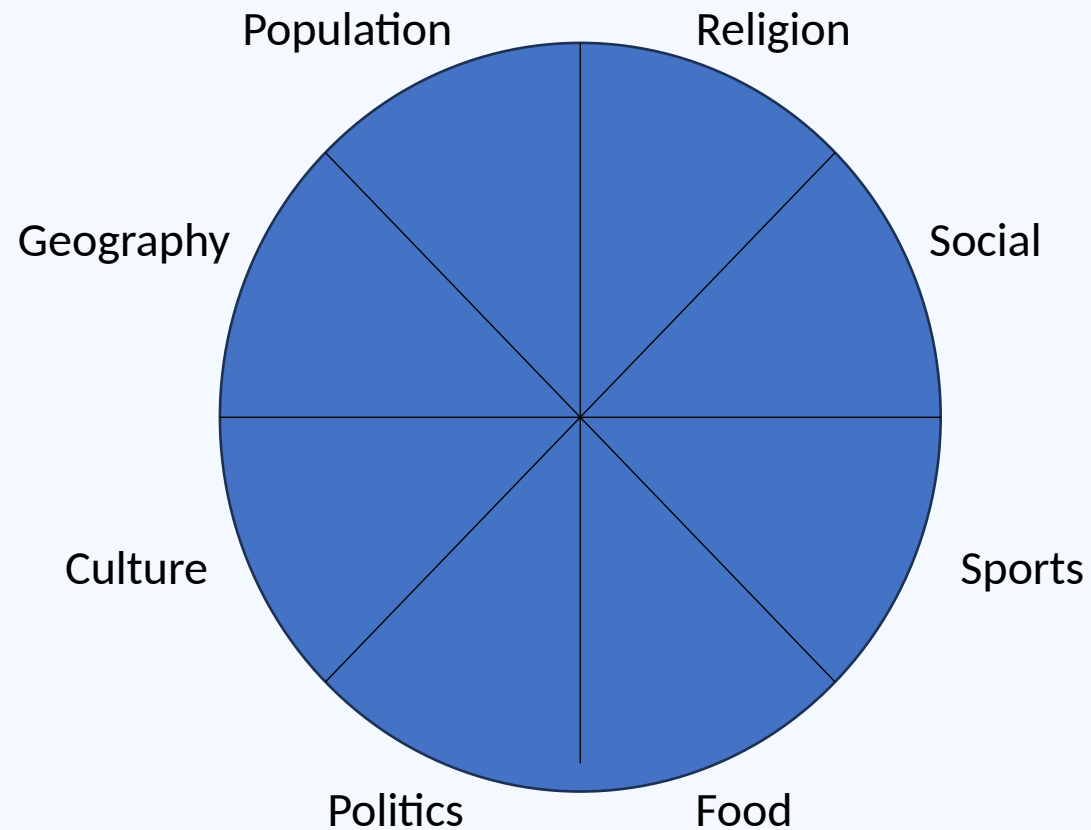

Set High Expectations if you want better results


Hold them accountable

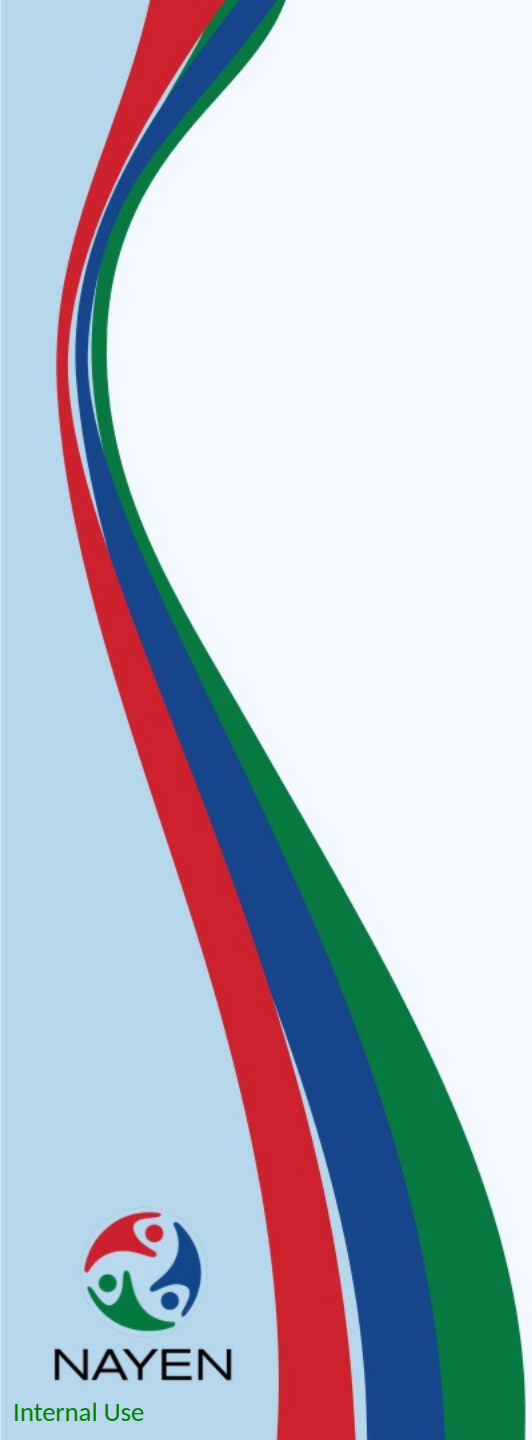
